


**BARKING DOG ORDINANCE
TOWN OF CHESTERVILLE**

No owner or person having custody of any dog within the legal limits of the Town shall keep or maintain a dog which creates a nuisance by continued or repeated barking, howling, making of other loud or unusual noises, or in any other manner disturbing the peace of any other person, or persons, after that owner, or keeper has been warned by any law enforcement officer, animal control officer, or other public official authorized for these purposes that his/her dog, or dogs, have been disturbing the peace and quiet of another person, or persons, A person who keeps or maintains a dog whose barking or howling, sustained for one hour or intermittently for three hours, can be heard at or beyond the boundary of the property on which the dog is located commits a civil violation for which a civil penalty shall be assessed.

Penalty. Any person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a civil penalty of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 shall be assessed. Any fine collected shall be recovered to the use of the Town of Chesterville and deposited in a separate account as required by Title 7, MRSA, Section 3945.






